**Rome**, Italy's capital, rises on the banks of the Tevere about 25 kilometers from its main outlet in the Tyrrhenian Sea. It is situated at the center of an undulating plain, the Campagna Romana, which is confined on one side by the hills of Monte Mario, Gianicolo and Monteverde and on the other side by smaller hills of volcanic origin - the so-called "Seven Hills." Two thousand years of history have made the artistic and architectural patrimony of Rome so rich that the tourist feels overwhelmed. Thus it is preferable to outline a precise program and to fix determined objectives, according to one's taste and the amount of time available.

## 1° Day – March 21 Friday

**0830** Approximate time to Pick up Camp Darby customers at the **AGIP station** located just out side of the exit of “Florence Nord” of the A1 Autostrata (high way) coming from Aviano,

NOTE: The cell phone # of our tour escort will be communicated before the tour departure

**1130** Approximate arrival in Orvieto where you can visit the town cathedral and admire one of the most beautiful samples of medieval architecture (the main church) and the St Brizio Chapel one of the samples of early Renaissance Italian masterpieces to compare with the Michelangelo Sistine Chapel (ENTRANCE FEES NOT INCLUDED APP.€5)

**1600** Approximate arrival in Rome. Visit of the Catacombs the early Christian burials. (ENTRANCE FEES NOT INCLUDED APP.€5)

**1900** Check in at the hotel and dinner (NOT INCLUDED). After dinner you will have free time to explore Rome by night on your own.

## 2° Day – March 22 Saturday

**0700** Early Breakfast at the hotel ( included)

**0830** Approximate departure from the hotel for a guided tour or a guided tour of the archaeological centre of the town. In the afternoon you will have free time for lunch, shopping and explore the Vatican area on your own. We suggest you to visit the “Vatican Museum”, “Cappella Sistina” and San Pietro area.

**1730** Approximate departure to the hotel get ready for dinner that it will be in a typical restaurant. ( included)

## 3° Day – March 23 Sunday

**0730** Approximate time for breakfast at the hotel; check out

**0900** Departure to “Piazza San Pietro” for the Holy Mass held by **the Pope**. Please note that the attendance inside the Basilica for the HOLY MASS WILL NOT BE GUARANTEED .

After the Mass or ( for those who do not go the religious service) guide of the Baroque heart of the city ( Spanish Steps Trevi Fountain, Venice square Navona Square Pantheon square).
