Do you know about the very special money-stretching opportunity available to many folks stationed in Italy? Individuals affiliated with the U. S. Forces with full logistical support are eligible to forgo paying the 21% Value Added Tax (VAT), or 'IVA' when shopping on the economy for household items.

To enjoy the benefits of this privilege, the first thing you need to do is pay a visit to the Camp Darby Tax Relief Office (TRO) located in Bldg 303.

The professionals at the TRO Office will go over the rules regarding VAT exemption and will explain how the program works.

Stores and businesses on the economy are not obligated to accept the VAT forms, so it's best to ask if your form will be accepted first.

For more information, contact the experts at the Camp Darby Tax Relief Office at DSN 633-7549. TRO is open Monday - Friday from noon to 4 pm.
