

Change in Local Italian Traffic Law

Mandatory Winter Tires or Chains

- **UPDATE - Italian traffic law released on 8 November 2011**, on the S.G.C. Firenze-Pisa-Livorno (FI-PI-LI):

Starting 15 November 2011 thru 15 April 2012 on FI-PI-LI

All vehicles shall be equipped with winter or all-season tires, or have snow chains on board. Additionally, if snowing, all vehicles driving on this road must proceed in single file on the right side of the lane (no passing), in order to leave room available for emergency vehicles. This will become an annual requirement on the FI-PI-LI during above time period.

- Attached is a list of additional roads in other regions of Italy that require winter or all-season tires or snow chains on board with date of enforcement for each area listed.
- Legal Reference: Atto Dirigenziale N.4105, **8 Nov 2011**, Provincia di Firenze.
- Fines: Local fines for non-compliance currently range from **€80 to €318**.
